# **Artist Parking Information**



#### **Access Passes**

Vehicle access to Julia Davis Park will be **restricted beginning Thursday morning, September 5** through Sunday night, September 8. Each vendor loading and unloading into the park must display the official *Art in the Park* Access Pass on their vehicle dashboard. This pass will grant access to the roadways of the park. <u>Driving on the grass or on the pathways of the park is strictly prohibited at all times.</u>

A temporary First Day Access Pass, which is **valid for Thursday, September 5 only**, can be downloaded <a href="https://example.com/here/first Day Access Pass link">here (First Day Access Pass link)</a>. You will need this Access Pass to gain entry to the park during the set-up process, which begins on Thursday, September 5 at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 7:00 p.m. **Please complete the required information on this pass and display it on your dashboard.** 

You will receive a yellow Access Pass in your check-in packet that is valid for the remainder of the weekend. Please complete the required information on the pass and display it on your dashboard for entering the park Friday through Sunday.

## **Overnight Parking Permits**

Please note that the Access Pass is separate from the permits required to park a vehicle overnight, or lodge in a vehicle overnight in the park. Please read the following information regarding overnight parking permits carefully.

### **Overnight Parking Permits**

If you plan to park a vehicle or trailer in Julia Davis Park overnight, you are required to submit an **Overnight Parking Permit Application and payment, for each vehicle, by <u>Friday, August 9</u>. You must apply and pay for this permit in advance. It will be included in your registration packet at check-in. Parking availability will be on a first-come, first-served basis. The fee for this permit is <b>\$30 per night (non-refundable), per vehicle**. Log in via the <u>BAM Artist Info Center</u> and click on "Overnight Parking Permit Application." If you need to park multiple vehicles overnight (a truck and a trailer, for instance), submit an additional form for each by clicking on the dropdown menu "Forms," and click on "Overnight Parking Permit Application."

### **Overnight Lodging Permits**

If you plan to sleep in your vehicle/RV/camper in Julia Davis Park, you are required to submit an **Overnight Lodging Permit Application and payment, by** Friday, August 9. You must apply and pay for this permit in advance. It will be included in your registration packet at check-in. The fee for this permit is \$30 per night (non-refundable), per vehicle. Log in via the BAM Artist Info Center and click on "Overnight Lodging Permit Application." Please note that vehicles permitted for Overnight Lodging must park in the Boise Pavilion Parking Lot (indicated in orange on the parking map). If your lodging vehicle is a trailer (separate from a towing vehicle), you must also submit a form for your towing vehicle, if you plan to park it overnight in Julia Davis Park. Click on the dropdown menu "Forms," and click on "Overnight Parking Permit Application."

Please note the deadline for overnight parking and lodging permit applications is <u>Friday</u>, <u>August 9</u>. There will be no reminders for this deadline. Permits will not be available after August 9.

Vehicles parked in fire lanes, loading zones, unauthorized spaces, or not parked within marked parking spaces may be towed.
